

# Peter Fribbins

A short biography

Peter Fribbins' music combines a gift for melody, drama and passion and is regularly performed internationally. Born in 1969, he studied with Hans Werner Henze and at the Royal Academy, Royal Holloway and Nottingham universities. There is now a corpus of some 30 works: his first string quartet, 'I Have the Serpent Brought' was also the title for the 2010 CD release of much of his chamber music for strings (recorded by the Allegri Quartet and Raphael Wallfisch amongst others). 2012 saw the CD release of his Piano Concerto (Royal Philharmonic Orchestra), the 2nd String Quartet (Chilingirian Quartet) and the Fantasias for Viola & Piano (Bradley and Hewitt). Peter Fribbins is also Director of Music at Middlesex University, and Artistic Director of the celebrated series of Sunday London Chamber Music Society Concerts, resident at Kings Place.
